



We have been showing Films in association with Moviola, who have been providing a mobile rural service, for 14 years. Unfortunately, COVID social distancing limits the audience size to 25 which would not have covered the hiring costs, so our 15 year was curtailed in April. We had been considering purchasing our own equipment for some time and with this closure we made the decision to try and raise the required funds to purchase a full-size screen, new sound system, projector and DVD player.

In December 2020 we launch [www.crowdfunder.co.uk/kilmington-village-community-cinema](http://www.crowdfunder.co.uk/kilmington-village-community-cinema) with a Target of £6,500. By the 5<sup>th</sup> January we have raised £3,650 plus an estimated £802 gift aid.

Our aim is to be able to run matinées, children films, niche films as well as popular evening film shows. Having our own equipment will make this a possibility.
